Thank you for another great week of remote learning! We are so proud of our students, families and teachers as we see learning and growth that takes place each day. We know that remote learning presents many challenges and we are thankful for your partnership and continued effort to make the most of learning each week. Overall we have 89% of our students engaging in remote learning over the last few weeks and 76% actively engaged last week. That means that 351 students were actively engaging in school work and zoom office hours last week! Great job, we look forward to your learning next week! Remember, to attend zoom office hours. Students will be able to engage with teachers teaching lessons, providing students with feedback regarding the weekly learning and interactive learning activities.

**E-mail Communication:** Thank you for the feedback that we need to improve e-mail communication, specifically, the subject lines of our e-mails. You will notice teacher e-mails will include the teacher name, subject and grade level in the title of e-mails. We want to be as clear as possible, to help our families! One area we could use your help; adding student names to e-mails. We love receiving student e-mails! **Grade Book Communication:** Grade book communication has changed a bit in remote learning due to our grading system shifting to **S** (Satisfactory work turned in and completed) **U** (Unsatisfactory work turned in, needing to be revised **OR** work never turned in) or **Blank** (work never turned in). Please review the notes left by teachers in the grade book to review the specific status of an assignment. The number of missing assignments will not "show" on the home page of synergy, therefore we must review each course to see the status of work completion. See example below:

### Join the #TestNebraskaChallenge

TestNebraska is a new initiative to dramatically increase the rate of COVID-19 testing. Every Nebraskan is being asked to go toTestNebraska.com and take a quick, five-minute assessment. This will help figure out where in the state testing needs to occur, and what your risk level is. Get started with three simple steps:

- 1. Answer a few questions to determine your current risk.
- 2. They can't test everyone, but they will prioritize testing for those who currently have symptoms, have interacted with someone who has already tested positive, or have recently visited places where COVID-19 is more widespread.

3. If you do test positive, they will ask you to answer some questions to help isolate the infection rate. Take the assessment now: TestNebraska.com.
